

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The documents listed below are required for enrollment into one of our programs of study. Failure to provide any of the listed documents will delay the enrollment process.



VALID – CLASS C DRIVER'S LICENSE

A valid Class "C" license is required to upgrade into a Class "A."



ORIGINAL (NOT LAMINATED) SOCIAL SECURITY CARD

The DMV will request this document to verify your identity



CHOOSE ONE: U.S. BIRTH CERTIFICATE, VALID U.S. PASSPORT, CERTIFICATE OF NATURALIZATION, OR RESIDENT CARD (MUST BE ORIGINAL)



DMV – DRIVING RECORD

These must now be obtained online or via a DMV kiosk.

HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR EQUIVALENT

Acceptable substitutes for a high school diploma include a GED, HiSET, college transcripts, adult school transcript, or **take a school entrance exam (reading comprehension score must be 7th grade level or higher)**. *Why is this required?* To attend a state-licensed vocational school (in California), enrollees must show proof of ability to benefit.



SELECTIVE SERVICES

Males who are looking to apply for funding must show proof of selective service registration. An admission representative can help you verify this requirement. You may also verify enrollment here: www.sss.gov
